

# Egublogs.org guide

---

- 1) Unzip files to the same directory on your machine.
- 2) First of all we should create accounts (blogs) to post there later. To do that we should put some entries to the file *details.txt*.
- 3) Add entries to details.txt in next form:

Blogname:blog description

Blogname2:blog description 2

...

So each line has a blog name and then blog description via colon.

- 4) The password is generated via macro `{-Random.Text-|-10-|-cd-}`

Example: JHDa32dssw

- 5) Emails are generated automatically via macros mix:

```
{-Person.HumanLogin-|--[Eng|4][RndNum|1970|1990]-}@{-String.Spintax-|-  
{gmail|yahoo|hotmail|mail}-}.com
```

Example: Andriano1988@gmail.com

You can change it if you need to take a line from file or something.

- 6) Captcha recognition was set up to MonkeyEnter.dll, if you want to solve it automatically you should change captcha recognition step.

- 7) Accounts details will be appended to a couple of files:

*Accounts.txt*

*Accounts\_BU.txt*

It may be useful because we are gonna use accounts with removing when will post articles.

- 8) So, everything is ready to run this template (edublogs\_accounts.xml). Add this to ZennoPoster and set up task on execution.

- 9) What about second template (edublogs\_post.xml). When we will post there our accounts entries will be removed from account.txt

```
{-File.GetString-|-{-Project.Directory-}accounts.txt-|-random-|-true-}
```

If you don't like this way just change this macro to

```
{-File.GetString-|-{-Project.Directory-}accounts.txt-|-random-|-false-}
```

- 10) Since this blog based on wordpress platform – posting there is pretty easy, but we should prepare some articles.

- 11) There is \articles directory in the template folder, each file there is article. Structure of file (article) has to be next:

First line: title of article, can be in spinnable form.

Example: {Worst|Best} article {ever|never}

Second line is used to choose posting format: HTML or not. If you want to post it in HTML form put HTML to the second line of file with article.

12) Next lines are article content, it also can be in spinnable form. Example:

{Hi|Hello}

How are {you|you doing}?

Bye.

13) Link to the post will be added to the *done.txt*
